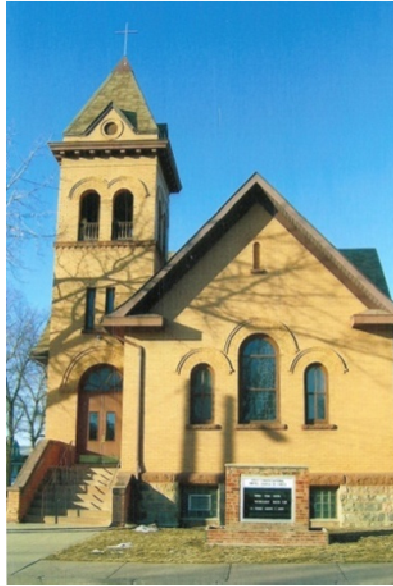

FIRST CONGREGATIONAL UCC GLEN ULLIN



Our light started shining in 1883. The First Congregational church of Glen Ullin was a joint venture of several Protestant denominations that were a part of this pioneer community.

Services were first held in the depot. Then they rented a house for \$2/month. They then built a wooden church building that was destroyed by fire. Hard working church members organized and built the current brick building that was built and dedicated in 1908.



The Ladies Aid society and Sunday School were organized in the 1980's and a men's group was formed in the 1950's. In 1960, the church joined the United Church of Christ.

Numerous church memorials have kept the church up-to-date and in good repair.

Our light continues to shine today as we help with service projects at the local nursing home and we continue to give donations to groups such as Youth Ministry, Wishek Retirement Home, Blanket Fund, OCWM, Jamestown State Hospital, Charles Hall Home, to name just a few.

Thanks to the dedication of many pastors and active members, the church has served the inspirational needs of many individuals over the past 124 years. We plan to hold a special 125th anniversary celebration in 2008.
