
MALCOLM CHURCH



Malcolm Church is a country church located about 12 miles north of I-94 on the Pettibone farm to market road. It is the only still active church of the four church Kidder County parishes. With a very small number of faithful members Jesus words. "For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them." are reinforced. In 2005 Malcolm Church was recognized as a Covenant Keeper, one of 988 UCC churches (out of 5883 congregations) that give more than 10% of their current operating budget to OCWM. They are also consistently a 5 for 5 churches. One of their most rewarding mission endeavors is sponsoring a little girl in the Philippines through the Global ministries Child Support program. Her letters to the church members are tangible evidence of her progress in school. There is one other church in Pettibone, a Missouri Synod Lutheran Church. Because of dwindling rural population, the two churches work together to serve for funerals, showers, anniversaries etc.; not individual congregations but a community of Christians. In 2008 Malcolm Church will be 100 years old - a reason to celebrate for this little white church situated off the beaten path. Licensed Minister, Joan DeKrey, is pastor of Malcolm Congregational UCC.
