We're turning 125 years old and will be celebrating our birthday on Sunday, May 6th ... so we are busy getting ready for a day of worship, memories, a shared meal and skit about the history of the church!

On Sunday, May 14th, 1882, the church was organized by David Wirt in the feed store of J. Roshold. The first sermon was preached by Mr. Wirt on July 26th, 1881. Services were held on an irregular basis until the church was organized in 1882. It was given the name Congregational Church of Mayville with four charter members. In 1882 a church was build, the first church building erected in Mayville, at the cost of \$1200. In

April 1888 the building was sold for \$215 and moved off the premises and a new building was erected the same year at the cost of \$2500. In 1950 a renovating and remodeling project on the kitchen and fellowship hall was begun, which took five years to complete. The entrance and narthex were completely changed in 1962, and the newest addition, consisting of the expansion of the sanctuary and the addition of a nursery and elevator facilities, was completed in 1990. The pipe organ was purchased and installed in 1927.

On March 5th, 1962, the members of the Mayville congregation voted to become the United Church of Christ. Twenty two pastors have served the church since its founding.
